1. Purpose of Agreement

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which the Owner agrees to rent the vehicle identified below to the Renter for the agreed rental period.

- The Renter agrees to operate and care for the vehicle responsibly and return it in the same condition in which it was provided, subject to reasonable wear and tear.

3. Rental Fee & Security Deposit

The Renter agrees to pay a rental fee of \$._____ for _____ hours/days/weeks.

A security deposit of \$._____ may be required before the vehicle is provided.

The security deposit may be used to cover any applicable fees, damage, loss, unpaid fines, cleaning costs, or other amounts owed under this Agreement.

- **Excessive speeding** accumulating up to 10 alerts will incur a \$100 deduction from the bond

Any remaining deposit will be returned to the Renter following inspection of the vehicle.

4. Responsibilities of the Renter

The Renter agrees to:

- Hold a valid driver's licence appropriate for the vehicle and provide evidence of the licence and passport when requested.
- Operate the vehicle safely and lawfully.
- Take reasonable care of the vehicle during the rental period.
- Return the vehicle on the agreed date and time.
- Return the vehicle with the same fuel level as at collection.
- Notify the Owner immediately of any accident, damage, mechanical issue, warning light, theft, or other significant problem involving the vehicle.
- Not allow another person to drive the vehicle unless expressly authorised by the Owner in writing.
- Not use the vehicle for racing, speed testing, burnouts, drifting, track events, or other dangerous or illegal activities.

5. Fuel / Refuelling

The vehicle will be provided with the agreed fuel level recorded at the time of collection.

The Renter must return the vehicle with the same fuel level.

- **If the vehicle is returned with insufficient fuel, a \$100 refuelling fee** will apply, in addition to any reasonable cost associated with replacing the missing fuel.

The Owner may deduct this amount from the security deposit.

6. Late Return

The vehicle must be returned on or before the agreed return date and time.

A \$50 per hour late-return fee will apply if the vehicle is returned after the agreed return time, unless the Owner has approved the late return in advance.

If the vehicle is significantly overdue, additional rental charges may apply at the agreed rental rate.

- The Renter must contact the Owner as soon as possible if they expect to be late.

7. Vehicle Condition & Inspection

The Owner and Renter should inspect the vehicle before and after the rental period.

Existing damage should be recorded before the vehicle is released to the Renter.

The Renter is responsible for damage caused during the rental period beyond reasonable wear and tear, except where the Renter is not legally responsible for the damage.

- The Renter should not attempt to repair, modify, or alter the vehicle without the Owner's prior approval.

8. Vehicle Modifications & Performance Features

The Renter acknowledges that the vehicle may be modified or have high-performance features and agrees to operate the vehicle responsibly.

The Renter must not:

- Modify, tune, remap, or alter the vehicle.
- Remove or interfere with vehicle components.
- Attempt to increase the vehicle's performance.
- Use launch control, racing functions, or similar features in a manner that creates unreasonable risk or damage.
- Use the vehicle in motorsport, racing, drifting, burnouts, or track activities.

Any damage resulting from misuse, negligence, or unauthorised modification may be charged to the Renter, subject to applicable law and the terms of any insurance policy.

9. Insurance & Driver Eligibility

The Renter must satisfy all applicable driver, licence, age, insurance, and rental requirements before taking possession of the vehicle.

- The Renter acknowledges that insurance coverage may be subject to specific conditions, exclusions, excesses, and authorised-driver requirements.
- The Renter must not operate the vehicle in any circumstance where doing so would invalidate or breach the applicable insurance policy.

10. Traffic Infringements, Tolls & Other Charges

The Renter is responsible for any

- Fines, including parking or any other fines
- Speeding or traffic infringements
- Tolls
- Road-user charges
- Impound or towing costs resulting from the Renter's conduct
- Defects, damages, or mechanical issues occurring during the rental period
- Other legally enforceable charges incurred during the rental period.

Where permitted by law, the Owner may recover these costs from the Renter.

11. Prohibited Use

The vehicle must not be used:

- For racing or competitive driving
- On a racetrack or closed-course event without the Owner's written permission
- For illegal activities
- While the driver is impaired by alcohol or drugs
- To transport hazardous or illegal materials
- By an unauthorised driver
- In any manner that could reasonably cause unnecessary damage to the vehicle.

12. Cleaning & Vehicle Care

The Renter must return the vehicle in a reasonably clean condition.

Excessive dirt, stains, rubbish, spills, smoke-related contamination, or other conditions requiring additional cleaning will result in a \$30 excessive-cleaning fee.

The vehicle must not be smoked in unless expressly permitted by the Owner.

13. Accidents, Damage & Mechanical Problems

In the event of an accident or damage, the Renter must:

1. Stop the vehicle when safe to do so
2. Contact emergency services where required
3. Notify the Owner as soon as reasonably possible
4. Provide all relevant information regarding the incident
5. Cooperate with any required insurance or police procedures.

The Renter must not admit liability or arrange major repairs without the Owner's authorisation, except where necessary to comply with the law or protect safety.

14. Breakdown

If the vehicle experiences a mechanical problem, the Renter must contact the Owner or the nominated roadside-assistance provider as soon as reasonably possible.

The Renter must not knowingly continue driving the vehicle where doing so could cause further damage.

15. Security & Vehicle Keys

The Renter is responsible for the vehicle keys during the rental period.

Lost keys, damaged keys, or costs resulting from the Renter's failure to secure the vehicle may be charged to the Renter where legally recoverable.

The vehicle must be locked and secured whenever it is unattended.

16. Termination

The Owner may terminate the rental agreement if the Renter:

- Breaches a material term of this Agreement;
- Uses the vehicle illegally or dangerously
- Allows an unauthorised person to drive the vehicle
- Fails to make required payments
- Provides false or misleading information.

Upon termination, the Renter must return the vehicle immediately or at the time directed by the Owner, subject to applicable law.

17. Liability

Nothing in this Agreement excludes or limits any rights or obligations that cannot legally be excluded or limited.

- The Renter remains responsible for losses or costs caused by their negligence, unlawful conduct, misuse of the vehicle, or breach of this Agreement to the extent permitted by law.
